- Uses: Good for emergency housing communities that do not want to go through RFP process
- Applicable Codes: Meets California Building Codes 2022 Appendix P Emergency Housing Requirements
- Lifespan: 20+ years
- Construction Materials: BOSS Steel Sandwich Panels
- Assembly Method: Shell (walls, roof, doors & windows) shipped to job site to be built on site
- Permitting: Approved by CA State DGS through AHJ (authority having jurisdiction)

Interim Premium

- Uses: Good for emergency housing communities
- Applicable Codes: Meets California Building Codes 2022 Appendix P Emergency Housing Requirements
- Lifespan: 20+ years
- Construction Materials: BOSS Steel Sandwich Panels
- Assembly Method: Shell (walls, roof, doors & windows) shipped to job site to be built on site
- Permitting: Through AHJ (authority having jurisdiction)

Permanent Housing

Permanent - HCD

- Uses: Good for smaller scale permanent communities (~ 25 - 50 homes)
- Applicable Codes: Meets California Building Codes 2022
- **Lifespan:** 30+ years
- Construction Materials: BOSS Wall Panels & Traditional Construction (steel studs, insulation, cement board, drywall)
- Assembly Method: Assembled in the factory (prefab)
- Permitting: HCD (Housing and Community Development) Commercial Modular

Permanent – Built on Site System

- Uses: Good for large scale permanent housing communities (~ >50 h omes)
- Applicable Codes: Meets California Building Codes 2022
- Lifespan: 30+ years
- Construction Materials: BOSS Wall Panels
 Traditional Construction (steel studs, insulation, cement board, drywall)
- Assembly Method: Shell (walls, roof, doors & windows) shipped to job site to be built on site
- Permitting: Through AHJ (authority having jurisdiction)
